Amount: \$4,500
Number: One award
Deadline: June 30, 2019

Criteria:

- Applicants must be members of Phi Beta Kappa elected at the University of Washington or the University of Puget Sound; and
- Beginning graduate or professional work at the University of Washington or the University of Puget Sound in the 2019-2020 academic year;
- Graduate study may be in the liberal arts, humanities, sciences, or professions;
- Financial need as demonstrated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) document on file at the applicant's current institution;
- Social utility of applicant's educational and career goals;
- Applicant's work experience;
- Achieving academic success in the face of significant personal adversity, economic disadvantage or disability, if applicable.

Procedure:

Each applicant must submit the following:

Signature on the application authorizes release of financial information. The institution will then have permission to confirm unmet financial need with the Association's Scholarship Award Committee.

1. Education and career goals
2. Statement of financial need
3. Description of the applicant's work experience and significant personal adversity, economic disadvantage, or disability, if applicable.
