**Amount:** \$4,500  
**Number:** One award  
**Deadline:** June 30, 2018

**Criteria:**

- Applicants must be members of Phi Beta Kappa elected at the University of Washington or the University of Puget Sound; and
- Beginning graduate work at either the University of Washington or the University of Puget Sound in the 2018-2019 academic year;
- Graduate study may be in the liberal arts, humanities, sciences, or professions;
- Financial need as demonstrated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) document on file at the applicant's current institution;
- Social utility of applicant's educational and career goals;
- Applicant's work experience;
- Achieving academic success in the face of significant personal adversity, economic disadvantage or disability, if applicable.

**Procedure:**

Each applicant must submit the following:

Signature on the application authorizes release of financial information. The institution will then have permission to share a copy of the applicant's financial aid award, student budget, Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and unmet need with the Association's Scholarship Award Committee.

3. Description of the applicant's work experience and significant personal adversity, economic disadvantage, or disability, if applicable.
